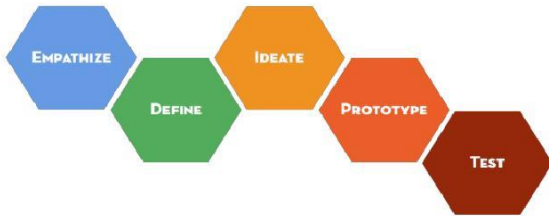




Design Thinking: for kid·FRIENDLY School Innovation Teams

Design Thinking is a systematic approach to uncovering rich and surprising insights and generating innovative solutions. The Rapid Cycle Challenge provides an opportunity for creative and divergent problem solving.



School Innovation Team members will have an opportunity to experience the Design Thinking Process with a focus on implementing their School Innovation Snapshot.

This customized one-day workshop will introduce participants to Design Thinking and model how to use the design process to thoughtfully and creatively identify ways to implement their School Innovation Snapshot. Using the design process developed by leading business and educational organizations like IDEO and the Stanford Institute of Design (or "d.school"), we will start our day learning the Design Thinking process then focus on the School Innovation Snapshot. We'll further explore those conversations for insights and brainstorm innovative ways to achieve the school's desired outcomes. Participants will emerge from this high-energy, collaborative workshop both motivated and equipped with some suggestions for reaching the future they described for their school.
