

In pursuit of the mission of Campbellsville High School, "to empower ALL students to be college and career ready", the Innovation Team and staff envisions a new, innovative approach to learning for our students that extends beyond the school day and outside the walls of our building.

Expanding our career pathway opportunities- By forming a Partnership

Exchange with area local school districts that are part of the Kid-FRIENDLY grant, Campbellsville High School students will have more interest based career course options, otherwise not currently available. After discussions with these school districts' administration as well as local business and industry contacts, the walls of a school building will no longer be a barrier to providing students learning opportunities that will both prepare and challenge them for future career planning. This partnership will allow our school to "exchange" students in order to provide the pathways and courses of interest. Based on student surveys, interest inventories, and conversations, the Innovation Team is committed to providing the necessary courses and pathway opportunities that students from larger school districts may have. Since our local area technology center (ATC) is in a neighboring county, transportation and daily schedules are currently in place to support this Partnership Exchange.

With this opportunity, our working relationships with area schools will be enhanced as we work together to provide opportunities for more students to earn the career readiness status through preparatory courses and assessments. Local business and industry will benefit from this partnership with more students having the knowledge and experience needed for apprenticeship and internship opportunities within our local communities.

Learning Academy Fridays- Since students are released early on Fridays, those additional two hours are an excellent opportunity to enrich and provide additional learning for students based on assessment scores, career interests, and individualized talents. Both Academic and STEAM Learning Academies will be a part of each Friday's release time. The Academic Learning Academy will include preparation for assessments (such as ACT workshops, benchmark intervention, and virtual learning seminars). STEAM Learning Academies will provide enrichment opportunities that will promote the whole student (through academic areas, leadership, and the arts).

Both of these areas of focus are important to students and staff at Campbellsville High School as we continue to make smart decisions on how better to meet the needs of our students. We are certain that with this focus, ALL students will have opportunities for empowerment that will help prepare them to be life-ready.
