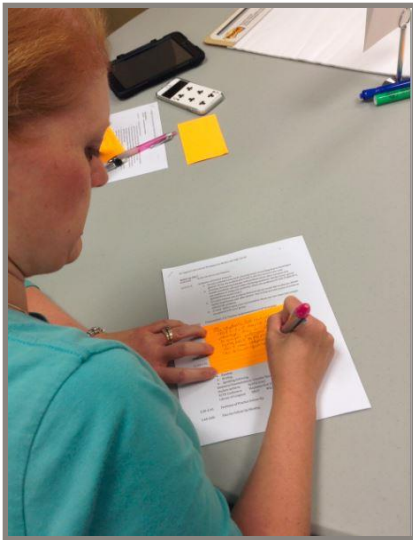


# Advanced Learning Workshop Series: Supporting Student Growth
